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PT Care in DMD

Continuum of care across phases

- diagnosis / early ambulatory phase
- late ambulatory / transitional
- early non-ambulatory
- late non-ambulatory

Coaching and anticipatory guidance
Range of motion
Functional mobility
Positioning
Skin management

PT Care in DMD

Coaching and Anticipatory Guidance

Preventive and protective daily routines more important than frequent formal PT Preparing for next phases

Range of Motion

Promote muscle length & joint range, delay contracture, preserve function, comfort Ambulatory phase via targeted active-assisted low-repetition exercises

Transitional and non-ambulatory phases

- expanding AAROM / PROM program
- 24hr positioning program

PT Care in DMD

Functional mobility

Ambulatory phase goal to protect muscles such as in means to rise from floor, to ascend stairs, recreation

Transitional phase adding wheeled mobility for distances and terrain to prevent falls

Non-ambulatory phase power mobility, mechanical lift

All phases to promote participation and quality of life for child and family

Positioning

Early ambulatory phase re: sitting posture, avoiding slouch to prevent spinal curvature (kyphosis, scoliosis) Transitional phase via wheeled mobility seating, and hip adduction strap for lying Non-ambulatory phase 24hr positioning program

- protect skin / integument
- promote seated symmetry and stability and head control
- prevent pain
